

## **Update for 2010!**

### **All livestock must have been Blue Tongue vaccinated prior to attending the Show.**

This year the Stockman's Dinner on Friday 11th June will be on a ticket basis purchased from the Cattle Secretary's caravan on Friday 11th June at £5.00 each. Green wristbands must be worn at all times to assist with security - replacement ones will be available from the mobile Secretary's caravans in the livestock areas.

Mobile shower and toilet blocks will be placed in the Green car park for your use and will be open from Tuesday 8th June 2010.

Finally, if you have a problem on your way to the Show and are running late, PLEASE let the Show office know on 01444 892700 or 0780 884 7972 as the Veterinary Surgeons will not be on site after 1700hrs on Tuesday and 19.00hrs on Wednesday evening and you will be turned away.

**Cattle:** Please do not bring animals to the Show without the necessary ear tags in.

**Pigs:** All pigs must have their registration numbers/date of birth and holding number on the entry forms for checking by the BPA. Piggy Pranks will take place on Thursday and Friday at 4pm each day. Due to lack of space, if you require a kit pen, this will need to be booked and paid for when making your entries on the remittance form - thank-you.

**Sheep:** Please make sure you are complying with the current DEFRA sheep tagging regulations.

**Goats:** The top 4 goats will be requested to parade in Livestock parade along with representations from the other breeds. Please note new contact details for the Entries Secretary.

**Horses:** Back by popular request – Pony Breeding in hand classes on Thursday. Also on Thursday are two new Side Saddle classes 435-436 in memory of the Late Jane Hallett.

**Showjumping:** New for 2010 is the Grand Prix class to be held on the Saturday. Also this year, we are delighted to host one of the 1.50m International Stairway Series classes that are being held around County Shows with a first prize of £2500. This class will be run on Friday 11th June. The Show has also been awarded a Grade C HOYS qualifier which will be held on Thursday 10th June. This year the Course designer is Bob Ellis assisted by John Farrell in the Balcombe ring.

We very much hope that you will enjoy your exhibiting experience at the Show this year and look forward to seeing you in June.
