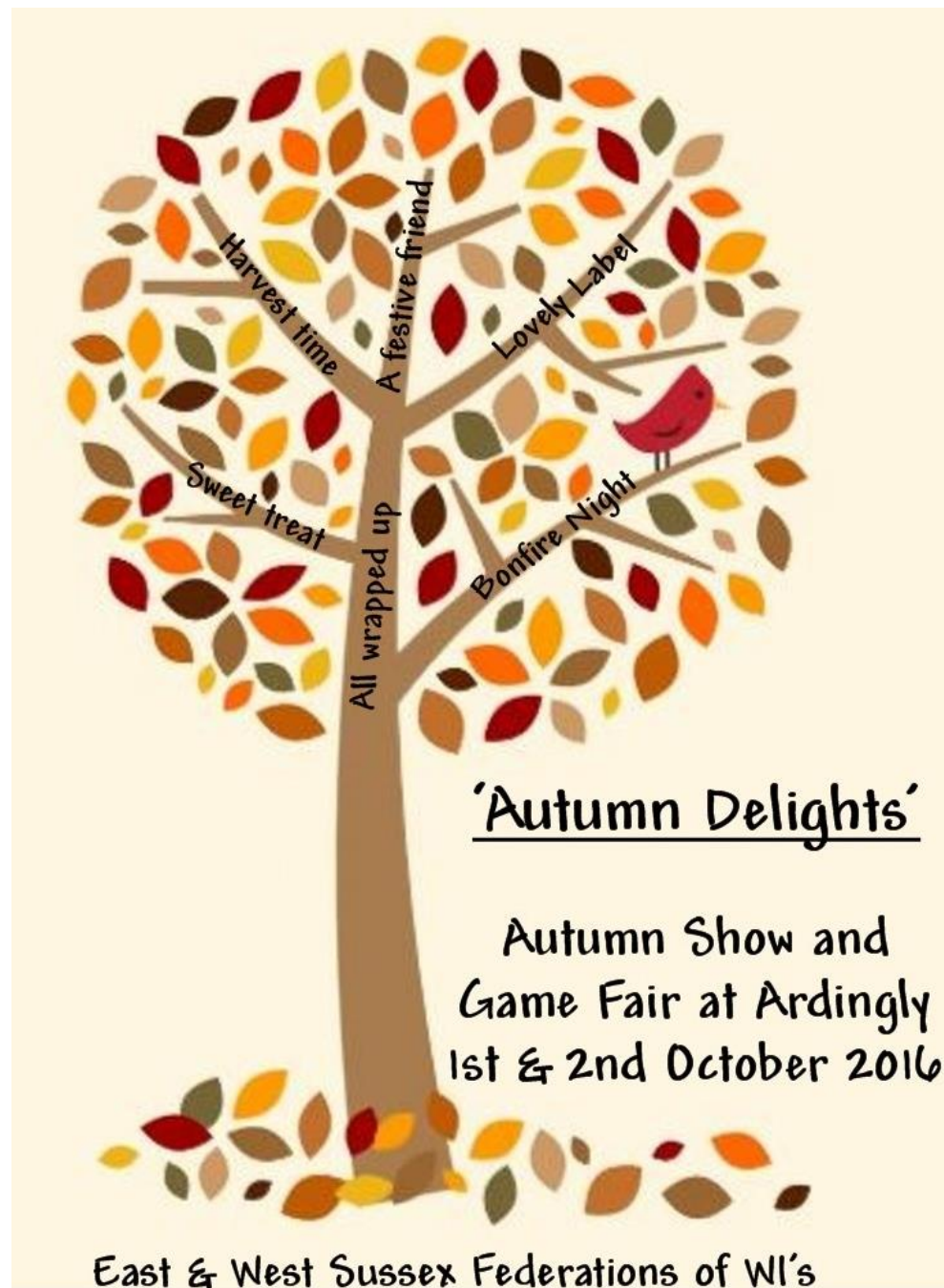


AUTUMN SHOW & GAME FAIR AT ARDINGLY 2016

MULTIPLE ENTRIES PERMITTED FOR ALL CLASSES

Class 1 “SOMETHING SAVOURY”

A quiche, size 15-20cm (6-8”) displayed on a plate. See p121 OWTS 2015. Please include the recipe (ingredients and method) on an A5 card.

Class 2 “HARVEST TIME”

A plaited loaf, size 450g/1lb, presented on a board. See p105 OWTS 2015.

Class 3 “FRUITY FLAVOURS”

A jar of fruit curd made from any fruit in a jar size approx 225g (8oz). See p133 OWTS 2015 for details of covering.

Class 4 “SWEET TREAT”

5 decorated cup cakes presented on a plate. All to be made from one mixture but may be decorated differently. See p109 OWTS 2015.

Class 5 “A TOUCH OF GLAMOUR”

An item of jewellery or a pair of earrings / cufflinks in any medium. See OWTS 2015 for advice on specific crafts.

Class 6 “ALL WRAPPED UP”

A decorated gift bag, handmade, any size, in any fabric (excluding knitting /crochet).

Class 7 “A FESTIVE FRIEND”

A hand knitted or crocheted stuffed Santa or Snowman. Can be a stuffed toy or a decorative item (please state which) and enclose a copy of the pattern or own design. See p65 or p78 OWTS 2015.

Class 8 “LOVELY LABEL”

A handmade gift tag made from an unfolded A6 card, decorated using papercraft techniques and/or painting. Attach a cord for hanging. Some guidelines can be found on p76 OWTS 2015.

Class 9 “BONFIRE NIGHT”

An exhibit of natural plant material. To be displayed on a board. Space allowed 60cm x 60cm (24”x 24”), height unrestricted. Accessories allowed. See p153 OWTS 2015.

MULTIPLE ENTRIES PERMITTED FOR ALL CLASSES

RULES

- 1. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT ALL PARTICIPATING MEMBERS ARE GIVEN A COPY OF THE SCHEDULE AND RULES. NB: Schedule is also available to view on Federation web-sites**
- The Schedule must be strictly adhered to, or the entry will be disqualified. **THE JUDGES’ DECISION IS FINAL.**
- Please refer to the NFWI “**On With the Show” 2015 Edition 6 Handbook (OWTS 2015)** for the definitions of the various classes (available on the Moodle)
- All exhibitors must be WI Members.
- Closing date for entries Friday 16th September 2016
- ALL WIs WHO ENTER MUST ENCLOSE TWO C5 23cm x 16cm (9"x 6½") STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPES.**
- WIs will be allocated a number in September and this number must be fastened to all items. Pre-Show Entry passes to the Showground for Judging Day will be forwarded as soon as they are available.
- In the event that a WI has to cancel any of their entries they **MUST NOTIFY THE SHOW DESIGNER.**
It is regretted that Entry Fees cannot be refunded.
- All Classes must be brought to the Showground on **Friday 30th September 2016 and staged between 9.30am and 10.30am.** The Room will be closed at 10.30am. Entry will be via the North Gate and round to the Blue Gate. Members may park briefly outside.
- ONLY TWO MEMBERS PER WI** will be allowed into the Room to avoid congestion.
- All items must be the property and unaided work of the Exhibitors. They must have been made within the last 12 months.
- If you have **multiple entries for a class** they will be labelled with your WI number and a letter a, b etc. On a piece of paper please list the names of the entrants next to the letter identifying their work and put it into an **envelope marked with your WI number and class.**
