Both Classes are open to Individuals, Young Farmers Clubs, Experienced & Inexperienced Flower Arrangers and Florists, Horticultural Clubs/Societies and Flower Clubs.

The theme for both classes is: 'A CELEBRATION OF AUTUMN'

Class 1 Beginners: for people with less than two years' experience in Flower Arranging or Floristry. To be displayed in a space half metre depth and width with no height restriction – to be viewed from the front.

Class 2 Intermediate / Advanced: for people with more than two years' experience in Flower Arranging or Floristry. To be displayed in a space of one metre depth and width with no height restriction – to be viewed from the front.

Entries close on Monday 21st September 2017

REGULATIONS

- 1. Judging on Friday 29th September 2017 at 6.pm Exhibitors** and the public will not be admitted to this section until judging is completed. Judge's decision will be final.
2. Exhibits to remain on view and intact until after prize giving on Sunday 1st October, when they are to be removed. Any items still on the premises on the following day will be disposed of by the Society.
3. Entries close on **21st September 2017.**
4. **Staging on Friday 29th September between 3.00pm and 7.00pm.**
5. Covered Trestle table(s) and grey cloth will be provided.
6. No sale of arrangements permitted until close of Show.
7. Each person entering will receive one free admission ticket. Admission tickets will only be given upon receipt of exhibit. Further tickets may be purchased at the gate (reduced rates for OAPs and free entry for children under 16 accompanied by a paying adult). Car parking is free.
8. Exhibitors are expected to comply with the instructions of the Stewards.
9. The entire risk and responsibility as regards all exhibits and in reference to all consequential or other injury or loss arising therefrom or thereto, must be borne by the Exhibitor. The Society will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit, in whole or in part, from any cause.
10. The Society reserves to itself by its Council and Committee, the sole and absolute right to interpret these or any other prescribed conditions and regulations and arbitrarily to settle and determine all matters arising out of or connected with or incident to the Show. Also to refuse or to cancel any entries and to postpone or abandon the Exhibition.
