Now in its thirteenth year, Connect with the Countryside supports the National Curriculum and gives pupils from over 50 schools in Brighton & Hove, East and West Sussex and Surrey an interactive, hands-on insight into farming, food, the countryside and the environment.

Four special zones engage pupils in a range of activities including:

1. **Livestock**, where pupils can meet a range of farm animals, from Sussex Beef bulls to chickens.
2. **Horticulture and Food**, where pupils can learn about healthy food, taste local tomatoes and peppers, fresh milk and honey and discover how sausages, bread and butter are made.
3. **Wildlife and Recreation (Indoor)** where pupils can experience corn dolly making, seed sowing, a bat hospital and wattle & daub.
4. **Wildlife and Recreation (Outdoor)** including gun dog training, fly fishing, hedge laying, forestry and conservation

Plus: 'The Sheep Show', Pony Club Display and a Birds of Prey demonstration. Pupils also have an opportunity to sit in the driver's seat of a tractor or combine harvester.
