Conditions of Entry for each Category

- The competition is free to enter
- KS1, KS2 and KS3 (ages 5 – 14) are invited to take part
- Entries can be a team/class/individual effort
- **No more than 1 entry per Category 1 and Category 2 and no more than 3 entries per Category 3** can be submitted for each KS1 KS2 and KS3 group
- You will need to provide your own materials
- **Category 1 - Plant and grow from seeds any plant or vegetables in the most innovative recycled container.** – Not measuring more than 50cm squared in size when displayed. An A4 laminated sheet to be included showing the reasons for the choice of seeds, the container and the journey of the growing exhibit.
- **Category 2 A mobile made from single use plastics with your personal environmental messages included within the structure.** – Maximum size 50cm width x 1 metre length. An A4 laminated sheet to be included showing the why the selected items were used
- **Category 3 A collage to reflect on the importance of trees in the environment.** 2-Dimensional art using any medium (NOT computer generated). Maximum A3 size. This must be suitable for hanging on a wall. An A4 laminated sheet showing the reasons for the design of the collage.

- All entries must be clearly marked on the back, or with a tie on label with School Name/Name of entrant, Key Stage Group you are entering and Category(ies) you are entering.
- Entries will be displayed during the South of England Show 11th 12th and 13th June 2020 in 'The Countryside Hub' - the Education stand in Discover the Countryside area.
- A prize will be awarded to the winner of each category for KS1 KS2 and KS3.
- Entries will be judged using the following criteria: Creativity, Quality, Presentation and Information.
- All decisions of the judge(s) are final.
- Entries may be photographed and displayed on the SEAS website and used for Marketing and PR purposes.
- Schools will be advised of the procedures for delivering and collection of entries nearer the time of the show.
- Please note that SEAS will endeavour to take every care of your entries but we can't be held responsible for them while they are at the Showground.
