Class 1 An arrangement of Flower and Foliage to the theme "Harvest.

> 60cm x 60cm - To be viewed from the front.

> 1A- Open to any person 12 years old and under

1B- Open to any person 1<mark>6 years and u</mark>nder

1C- Open to any person over 16 years

An arrangement of shop brought flowers in Class 2

Autumnal colours. With use of free hedgerow and garde<mark>n folia</mark>ge. To be viewed from the front - no bigger than 60cm x 60cm

2A- Open to any person 12 years old and under

2B- Open to any person 16 yea<mark>rs and under</mark>

2C- Open to any person over 16 years Higher marks will be awarded when substainable mediums are used, rather than oasis at the Autumn show 2025

REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries close: Monday 22nd September 2025.
- 2.Staging: Friday 26th September between 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm
- 3. Staged on trestle tables covered in pale grey material.
- 4. For class 2 a maximum spend of £20 is permitted. A receipt should be shown upon staging.
- 5. Please provide your own vase or staging for Classes 1 and 2.
- 6.Entries to remain intact until 4.30 pm on 28th September 2025.
- 7. Each person entering will receive one free admission ticket at Staging on Friday 26th September 2025 ie admission tickets will be given only on receipt of exhibit. Further tickets may be purchased at the gate or one line at seas.org.uk/autumn-show. To take advantage of the 10% discount until 19/09/2025 please purchase tickets on-line at seas.org.uk/autumn-show.
- 8. Exhibitors must comply with the instructions of the Stewards.
