The competition is open to Individuals, Groups and Classes

<u>Size</u>

Must not exceed 60cm x 60cm or up to a 25l container

Entries

All entries must be received by 25th May 2026.

Entries after this date may not be accepted.

Each entry will receive one adult admission ticket into the show.

Entries must be delivered to the Horticultural marquee by 6pm on

Thursday 4th June.

<u>Assessment</u>

There will be four main considerations that the judges will be assessing.

These are: Creativity, Use of Container, Use of Colour and Overall Design.

Awards

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

If you would like to collect your container after the show, please collect after 4pm on Sunday 7th June or between 9am and 5pm on Monday 8th June.

Please note if you are collecting your container on the Sunday that cars are not able to access the showground until after 6.30pm.



Regulations

- 1.The competition is open to children aged 2 16 years old
- 2.Entries can be a team/ class or individual effort
- 3. You will need to provide your own materials
- 4.All entries must be marked with School name, group, club etc and name of entrant(s). Any items that are not clearly marked will be withdrawn from judging.
- 5.Each entry will receive 1x one day adult ticket into the show.

 Children under 16 years of age get free entry to the show,
 but must be accompanied by an adult
- 6.Entry forms must to received by May 25th 2026
- 7.Entries must be on site by 6pm on Thursday 4th June 2026 and dropped off in the Horticultural marquee
- 8. Judging will commence at 8am on Friday 5th June 2026
- 9.Hotels can be collected from 4.30pm on Sunday 7th June 2026 or between 9am and 5pm on Monday 8th June 2026. After this point we do not have the provision to store the entries. Please note if you are collecting your hotels on the Sunday that cars are not able to access the showground until at least 6.30pm.

Please note on the entry form you must specify if and when you are going to be collecting your hotel.
