Conditions of Entry

- · The competition is free to enter.
- · Children aged 2 to 14 are invited to take part.
- Photo taken by yourself of your favourite animal friend- this can be any animal but must have been taken by yourself.
- . Vegetable animal- the body of the animal must be made using a solid carrot the rest of the animal can be made using any other natural items/ vegetables no manmade objects to be used. (Twigs, stones, chalk and leaves)
- . Song- this must be no longer or larger than an A4 side of paper. The nursery rhyme can be any of your choosing however this must be detailed at the top of your song.
- . Miniature gardens in Jam jars- must be contained to the jar. The jar can be of any size.
- · All entries must be clearly marked with School name/name of entrant, age group you are entering and class (es) you are entering.
- · If entries are not clearly labelled, they will be withheld from being judged.
- · Items must be delivered by 5pm on the 3rd June 2026, as judging takes place on Thursday 4th June 2026, at 10am sharp.
- Entries will be displayed during the South of England Show 5th, 6th and 7th June 2026 in 'The Countryside Hub' the education stand in 'Discover the Countryside' area.
- · A prize will be awarded to the winner of each class for each age group.
- Entries will be judged using the following criteria: creativity, quality, presentation and information.
- · All decisions of the judge(s) are final.
- Entries may be photographed and displayed on the SEAS website and used for Marketing and PR purposes.
- · Schools and parents will be advised of the procedures for delivery and collection of entries nearer the time of the show.
