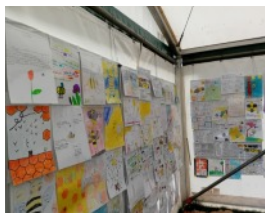

# South of England 2025

## Bees & Beekeeping Show



The SoE Honey Bees & Beekeeping Show is staged by volunteer members of a 'Bees & Honey' sub-committee of the South of England Agricultural Society, at the South of England Showground, in Ardingly, West Sussex.

For 2025, the show occupied a 12m x 36m marquee with viewing, by a seated audience, of a walled 12m x 6m apiary area through a transparent end wall, within the SEAS showground. Appropriately located along Queen's Street, between the Green and Blue Gate entrances, the marquee once again provided "must go-to" content for public attending the SEAS South of England Show, during Friday 6th, Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th of June.

Beekeepers from throughout the South East of England are able to participate in displaying, safely demonstrating and in talking about Honey Bees and Beekeeping to the visiting public.

Content included ...

- **Live Inspections of full Colonies of Bees ...**
  - presented on the hour from 10am to 4pm each day.
  - beekeepers opening, in rotation, one of four hives in the demonstration apiary.
  - commentaries to viewing audiences by another beekeeper inside the marquee.
- **Observation Hives**, providing VERY up close views of activities within a hive, by bees still able to forage via 'snorkel tubes' to adjacent display gardens.
- **Bees, Beekeeping, Training and Membership** information displays.
- **Bees & Honey Poster Competition** entries displayed, open to School or Youth Groups.
- Practical demonstrations of
  - *A live colony within a Tree Trunk.*
  - *The craft of Skep Making.*
  - *Microscopy and the honeybee's anatomy.*
- **Yellow Legged Asian Hornet** public awareness raised with the display of a table top enlarged model and information banners, and by engaging with and distributing information on leaflets and small cards to visitor to the marquee.
- **Trade Stalls** selling wax products, cosmetics, beekeeping equipment and mead.

Setting-up for the show was able to be completed during the preceding Thursday. The organising team led and supervised the many additional volunteer beekeepers during the three days of the show, needed to carry out; the hive inspections; provide commentaries; attend the observation hives; provide demonstrations of related craft skills; and look after our stall holders. As well as, of course, conveying our passion for beekeeping to the visiting public and hopefully satisfactorily answering their many questions.

# South of England Honey Show

## 2025 Event Report



The SoE Honey Show is staged by volunteer members of a 'Bees & Honey' sub-committee of the South of England Agricultural Society, at the South of England Showground, in Ardingly, West Sussex.

For 2025, the show once again occupied the Farmers Room (and its entrance lobby) within the showground's Norfolk Pavilion, as part of the **Autumn Show & Horse Trials** event, during Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th of September.

The event provided an opportunity for beekeepers, throughout the South East of England, to participate. Not simply in a friendly Honey Show Bench competition, but to also display, demonstrate and make available to the visiting public, the diversity and quality of locally produced products of the hive.

Content included ...

- A colourful & diverse Honey Show bench display with over 100 exhibits of *Honey in Jars, Comb and Frames; Beeswax; Mead; Honey Cakes & Biscuits; Beekeeping related Photography*; and creative presentations of *Bounty from the Hive*.
- Information displays about *Honey Bees & Beekeeping*
- Practical demonstrations of *Microscopy*, revealing the complexity of the honeybee's anatomy.
- Raising awareness of the threat posed by the *Yellow Legged Asian Hornet* with a static enlarged model, distributing information on leaflets and credit card sized cards, displaying information banners and donning a YLH costume to interact with the public elsewhere in the show-ground.
- **Trade stalls** selling wax products, cosmetics and honey marmalade.
- The 'Bees & Honey' Honey Sales stall ...
  - Selling jarred and comb honey, on behalf of participating Beekeepers from between London and the south east coasts.
  - Enabling and offering tasting of the 22 different honeys on sale, varying in their colour, texture and flavour ... before the almost inevitable purchase!

Setting-up for the show was largely able to be completed during the preceding Friday. The organising team then worked during the two days of the show, along with additional volunteers, to provide the stewarding required, looking after our stall holders, supervising all the content and, of course, conveying our passion for beekeeping to the visiting public.

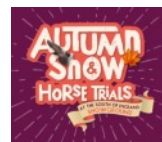
